- Have at least a 2.8 cumulative GPA
- Be an upper-classman student (junior or senior with 30 hours or less remaining to graduate)
- Be pursuing a degree related to the new STEM majors (Software Engineering, Game Development, CIS, Graphic Design, Music, Animation, etc.) and Business majors (Marketing, Accounting, Finance etc.)
